Pediatric care is essential for your child's good health. Gifford's providers are there for you and your child in sickness and also for routine, preventative care.

Well child visits to review health, development and provide appropriate vaccinations are performed just following birth; at age 2 weeks; at 1, 2, 4, 6 and 9 months; at 1 year; 15 months; 18 months; annually from ages 2-6; and from ages 6-13 visits often reduce to every other year and then resume annually after age 13.

If your child has missed an appointment, please schedule a visit with a family or pediatric health care provider. The medical center's primary care nurses are also available to answer questions as they arise.
