The Philip D. Levesque Memorial Community Award

The Philip D. Levesque Memorial Community Award was established by the Board of Trustees of Gifford Medical Center in memory of the late Phil Levesque who served as President and Chief Executive Officer of Gifford from 1973-1994. Each year a \$1,000 grant will be awarded to a community agency or organization involved in one of the following areas: arts, community development, education, environment, and health. "This annual award recognizes Phil's personal commitment to community service during the twenty-one years he lived and worked in the Randolph area," said CEO Joseph Woodin.

Consideration will be limited to inquiries from within Gifford's service area, with priority given to those proposals that positively affect the most members of the White River Valley community. Grants are not given to support general operating expenses. Requests must be made in writing by **February 5, 2010** and include:

- Detailed one-page description of the project
- Estimated budget and timeline for completion
- Expected results and benefits
- Copy of organization's 501(c)(3) certificate

A specially appointed committee of hospital staff, physicians, and Levesque family members will review all proposals. Announcement of the grant award will be made at Gifford's Annual Meeting March 6, 2009.
